

A: Duplin County, North Carolina

1. Land owned by Andrew Bass (1730).
2. 1758: Probable Birthplace of Rice Bass.
3. 1790: Census shows Rice residence in Wayne County (adjacent to Duplin)

B: Cumberland County, North Carolina

1. 1794: Birthplace of Needham Bass (1794)
2. 1799: Rice purchases land from John Colbreath.
3. 1800: Census shows Rice Bass and family's residence. (also John and Herman)
4. 1820: Census shows Rice Sr's residence.
5. 1824: Rice sells the land purchased in 1799 to Akies and Quincy.
6. 1830: Census shows Needham's residence. (also Akies, John and Quincy)
7. 1834: Akies and Quincy sell a different parcel of land to John Potter. (Perhaps as they were about to move to Sumter, Georgia).

C: Sumter County, Georgia

1. ~1830-1833 (or ~1836): Needham and brothers moved to Sumter.
2. 1839: Birthplace of William Crawford Harris Bass
3. 1840: Census shows Needham and family's residence. (Also John and Quinney)
4. 1850: Census shows Needham and family's residence. (In Irwin County, Georgia, right before move)

D: Marion County (Ocala), Florida

1. 1850: Census shows as Needham and family's residence.

E: Orange County, Florida

1. 1860: Census shows Needham and family's residence.
2. 1870: Census shows Needham and family's residence.
3. 1880: Census shows Crawford and family's residence.
4. 1885: Census shows Crawford and family's residence.
5. 1885: Census shows William R and family's residence.

F: Kissimmee, Florida

1. 1900: Census shows William R. and family's residence. (Osceola County)

G: Fort Myers, Florida

1. 1910: Census shows William R and family's residence.

H: Pahokee, Florida

1. 1924: Birthplace of Ernest Ralph Bass Jr.

I: West Palm Beach, Florida

1. 1930: Census shows Ernest Sr, Mina and Ernest Jr's residence.
