- (A) Andrew Bass Sr (1698-1770): b: Norfolk, VA /l: Dobbs / d: Craven Co, NC
- *note: Eventually owned over 5000 acres in North Carolina via numerous land grants. Had land in Johnston, Dobbs and Wayne Counties. Incl: 200 acres in Duplin in 1768.*
 - 475 acres, Craven County, 1737, 650 acres, Craven County, 1739, 450 acres, Craven County, 1757, 309 acres, Johnston County, 1756, 475 acres, Johnston County, 1759, (A.1) 200 acres, Duplin County, 1768^[3]
- (B) Thomas Bass (1719-1786): b: Norfolk, VA? / d: Bertie Co, NC
- (C) Thomas Bass (1740): b/d: Wayne Co, NC
- (D) Jesse Bass (1767):
- (E) Everett Bass (1774): l: Sampson Co, NC
- (F) Dr. Andrew Bass Jr (aft 1730): b: Craven Wayne or Wales, l: Waynesboro
 - Conflicting info on birthplace. Some sources say Craven Co , NC. The "Heritage of Wayne Co" states he and his wife Alice were born in Wales and came to Waynesboro before the Revolutionary War.
- (G) Andrew Bass Jr (1756-1791): b: Wayne Co, d: Wayne Co. (most often confused Andrew with ours and where lines are often crossed. His son, Uriah Benjamin Bass is then often confused with our Rice (possibly went by Uriah though I have not seen proof of this) and the lines are often mistakenly merged. Uriah Benjamin Bass married ... and moved to and died in Alabama.
- (H) Andrew Bass (1778-1836): b: Wayne Co, d: Wayne Co. l: Johnston Co in 1820 and 1830 census.
