This Indenture, Made this 24th day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty three between Rice Bass of the County of Cumberland in the State of North Carolina of the one part, and Achie's Bass & Quincy Bass his two sons of the County aforesaid and State aforesaid of the other part: Witnesseth, That the said Rice Bass for and in consideration of the sum of Thirteen dollars to him in hand paid by the said Achie's Bass & Quincy Bass at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, - hath given, granted and bargained, sold, aliened, remised, released and confirmed and do by these presents, give, grant, bargain and sell, alien, remise, release and confirm, unto the said Achie's Bass & Quincy Bass their heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Cumberland and State of North Carolina between the Head of Evans's Creek & great Creek beginning at a Gum in the South East corner of an open pond 70 yards South of the main Road thence S. 46° poles to a pine by great Creek thence East 220 poles thence N. 22° poles thence West 220 poles to a Blackjack thence S. 60 poles to the beginning. - To have and to hold the said land with its appurtenances to the only proper use, behoof and benefit of the said Achie's Bass & Quincy Bass their heirs and assigns forever: And the said Rice Bass for himself and his heirs, executors and administrators, do covenant promise and agree to and with the said Achie's Bass & Quincy Bass their heirs and assigns that the said Achie's Bass & Quincy Bass their heirs and assigns, and every of them shall have, hold, occupy, possess and enjoy the said land with its appurtenances without any let, suit hindrance, molestation or eviction from or by the lawful claim or claims of any person or persons whatsoever, to warrant and forever defend by these presents. - In Witness whereof, the said Rice Bass hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year first above written.
