Needham Bass (not ours) married Mary Ann B in 1795.

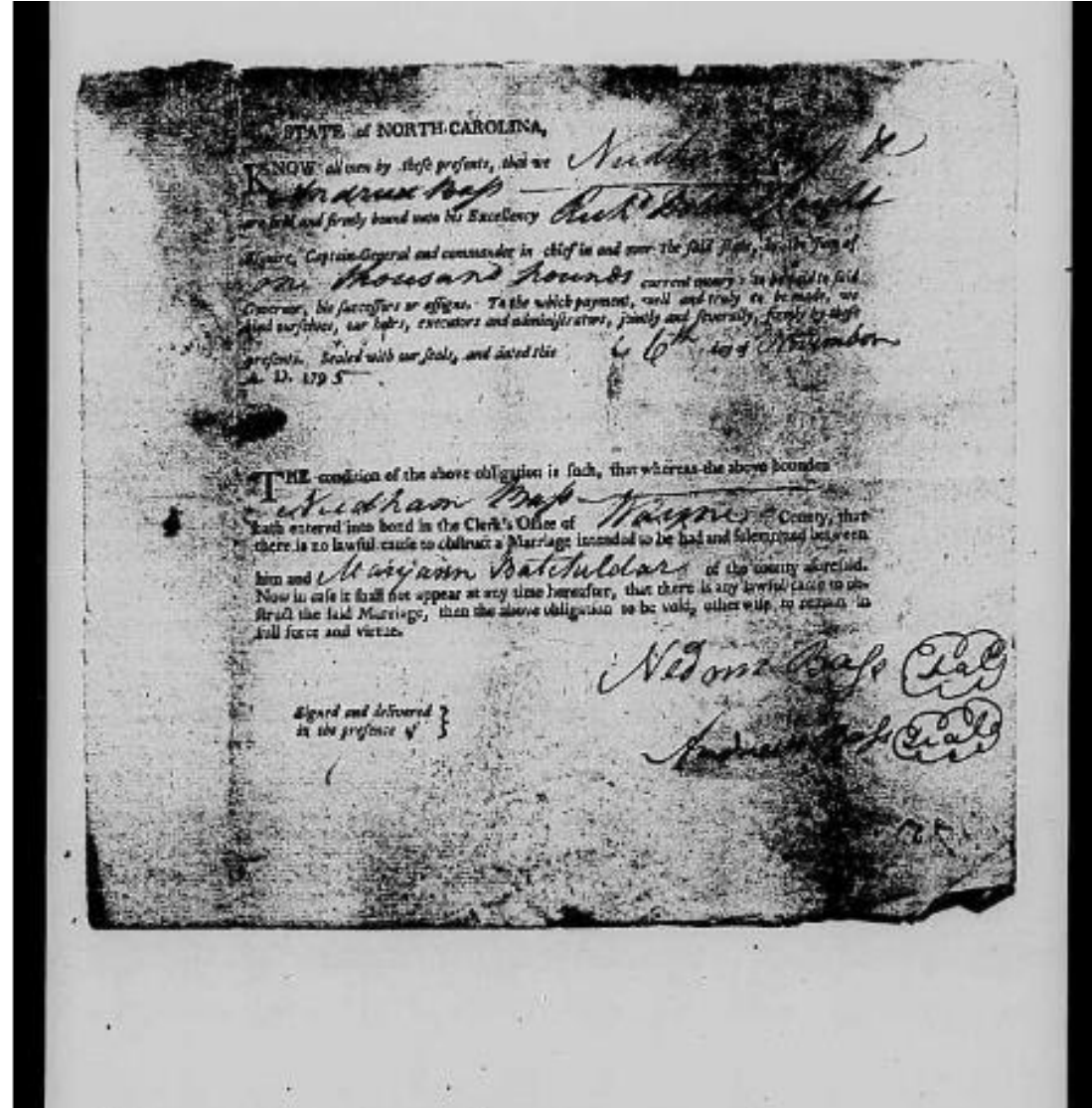
